The Chamber Choir entertained us with a selection of songs and their performance of the School Prayer clearly brought back some special memories for our alumni audience.

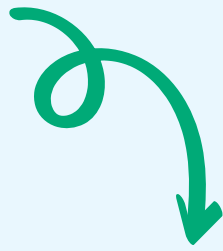
Two of our Head Pupils, Alex H and Dominic P reflected on their journey through the school.
